 - Watch the women weavers at Alola Esperanca women's weaving workshop and shop
 - Stroll around the Taibessi fruit and vegetable market
 - Visit Tasi Tolu (3 waters), Peace Park and the Pope John Paul II statue
 - Explore Cristo Rei and Areia Branca beach
 - Return to hotel at 12:30 (morning tour) or 17:30 (afternoon tour)
